## MY EMERGENCY NUMBERS - Psalm 18:1 I am Weak

Being weak physically is not the point here. This condition is internal; it is the feeling that you cannot make it; you will not be able to withstand the pressure; you feel damaged and fragile at times. You won't admit it.

- 1. King David faced this. What did he do? (Psalm 18:1)
- 2. What words did he use to describe that God was able to help him?

Keep in mind that when David wrote & prayed these words, he was being chased by King Saul; he was trying to kill David. Duh!! Who wouldn't feel weak inside if you were being chased by the entire government.

3. What confidence did David have?

- a. I will \_\_\_\_\_\_ upon the \_\_\_\_\_\_. (Psalm 18:3)
- b. I will be \_\_\_\_\_\_ from my \_\_\_\_\_. (Ps. 18:3)

If you are going to put your confidence in Someone, you want to be sure that you can reach this person, and that He can help you. I don't need to tell you that God can be reached, and He can help you.

- 4. David was in bad shape. Fill in the words from Psalm 18:4-6.

Yes, you have felt this way. People considering suicide are surrounded; there is no escape. David prayed, my friend. We are not always very good at that WHEN WE LEAST WANT TO PRAY, THAT'S THE TIME TO DO IT.

5. What good news did David discover? (Psalm 18:6)

Here's an issue that bugs people when they pray. We are impatient & scared & angry and desperate and alone. We want an answer NOW. Me too. Can I comfort you with this? The answer might not be there yet because He is still working in our lives & in our circumstances, BUT HE HEARD YOU!!

6. Here's a hard question. Do you think God really cares about your troubles, and wants to help you, yes, all the time? Please comment.

Get your kleenex ready. This powerful God we often doubt is ready. How ready? Look at Psalm 18:7-16. He is ready at the moment you called; He is holding back all the power of Heaven; He is holding back the powerful angels until the right time. GOD KNOWS THE RIGHT TIME.

7. "The earth \_\_\_\_\_." (Psalm 18:7)

"The foundations of the hills were \_\_\_\_\_."

"He was angry." (He is angry about your condition; He cares.)
