

John has been working on his college work with us for 14 years. Today, I mailed him his diploma. The chaplain of the prison where he lives is going to conduct a graduation ceremony for John. Thanks, Lord, for this moment of encouragement. Thank you for keeping us faithful.



Thanks to all who responded to my request for funds to buy study Bibles. We received enough money to order 20 Bibles; we got a great price from Amazon & were able to stretch the funds. As the men mature in their studies, they are then encouraged to purchase a study Bible either from

us or from a vendor of their choice. If a man has \$25, we encourage him to pay for the Bible. If he is short of funds, we subsidize the cost of the Bible. There are other men who have no funds nor sources of funds. Our goal is to get a good study Bible into the hands of these men when they are ready to use it properly. When we have need of other textbooks, we will keep you posted.

Keep praying for our monthly finances & for Liz's current legal proceedings. God constantly proves Himself to be faithful. Pray that we will be faithful & full of integrity.
