The Jews **have not kept** their Agreement: Godliness a. Malachi 1-3 b. Malachi 4:1-6 God has kept His Agreement: Glorious Future

The "Glorious Future" includes: The enemy (evil people) will be eliminated. (Forever) God will give us healing, energy, & purpose.(Forever) (Malachi 4:1-3)

## An Outline of Nehemiah

To help us understand what Malachi was dealing with, let's look into Nehemiah. a. Nehemiah 1-6 (In Jerusalem)Rebuilding the Wall Around the Cityb. Nehemiah 7-12 (Gone for a while)Rebuilding the Law Around the People

Nehemiah arrived in Jerusalem 13 years after Ezra got there. Nehemiah stayed there for 12 years; once the obstacles were dealt with during those years, they built the complete wall in 52 days. Yikes!

Part of Nehemiah 7-12, Nehemiah returned to Persia as he had promised the king. Ezra the priest & Malachi the prophet would have been on duty in Judah.
