A Closer Look - 8

A Personal Bible Study in Philippians 3:1-4:23)

This is a Biblical investigation into the Letter to the Philippians. At the end of this study, we will have a better understanding of what Paul wanted to share with these people and how he communicated to them.

For this study let's name the theme of the whole letter: Live Your Faith the Right Way: Serve the Lord

Let's divide the letter into these sections:

Always Be Ready to Serve the Lord (1:1-2:4)

Watch the Way Others Serve the Lord (2:5-30)

Go Out and Serve the Lord (3:1-4:23)

This is totally your study. Nobody will be instructing you and nobody will be grading you. It will just be you, your Bible, these lessons, your own paper, and of course, the Holy Spirit guiding and teaching you.

As Paul reminded us, while we are living our life & serving God, we must:

Not rely on our own abilities & background (3:1-6)

Realize only Jesus can accomplish His plan for our lives (3:7-10)

Focus on your own growth & maturity all along the way (3:11-16)

Pursue the goals & rewards that please God & benefit us (3:17-21)
