Let's be clear. We inherited a sinful nature from Adam; <u>that did not reduce my value</u>. I could not pay for my own sin; I was hopelessly sentenced to death. <u>That did not reduce my value</u>. Jesus paid the price for my sin and I accepted that for me; <u>that did not change my value</u>. There is nothing I can do to be holy on my own; I cannot please God on my own; I sin and fail God almost daily; <u>none of that reduces my value</u> to God.

GUILT = I AM SORRY FOR WHAT I HAVE <u>DONE</u>. God says, "I accept that." SHAME = I AM SORRY FOR WHO I <u>AM</u>. God says, "I do not accept that." The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit together created me in "OUR likeness". God says, "I covered your sin with Jesus' blood. I put the robe of righteousness on you. Your sin and failure is forgiven. YOU ARE STILL VALUABLE TO ME."
