As you can see, this lesson is quite long & involved; however, the message is clear:

You can see how the covenants progressively build upon one another forming a backbone to the story of redemption.

God preserved the WORLD through NOAH. (Through the world)
God began REDEMPTION through ABRAHAM. (Through a family)
God formed a special NATION through MOSES. (Through nation)
God promised a SHEPHERD-KING through DAVID. (Through a kingdom)
God fulfilled ALL COVENANT PROMISES through CHRIST. (Through Messiah)

GOD WANTED TO SAVE HIS PEOPLE (ALL PEOPLE). WITH EACH COVENANT, GOD'S PROMISES TO SAVE THE WORLD BECAME CLEARER - THEN, WE SEE THAT REDEMPTION (BEING SAVED FROM FROM) <u>CAN ONLY COME THROUGH</u> JESUS CHRIST.
