PRAISE

Whether you are a religious person or not, the word "praise" has a rather lofty sound to it. Who does the "praising": a minister? a priest? a rabbi? It sounds like a church-related thing, doesn't it? Is it something people like us can do?

Does that look familiar? "Hallel" = "praise; "Jah" = means "Lord". Put them together: "Hallelujah" = "Hallel" + "Jah" = "Praise the Lord". Psalm 134:2 - Lift up your hands in the sanctuary, and bless the Lord. ("Bless" & "praise" basically mean the same thing) "To praise the Lord" is to tell God you love Him, you are proud of Him, He gets all the credit for everything, you are willing to make all that known to others ("to shine").
