THE CHURCH

The **Greek** word for "church" = "EKKLESIA" = EK + KLESIA = OUT + CALLED In other words, "set apart and called out ones".

When the Apostle Paul was writing to the Corinthian church, he was concerned about their worldly life-style. They were not living any differently that the evil society around them in the city of Corinth.
