THE HUMAN (SIN) NATURE



Christian counselor will say: Set boundaries on behavior & do not cross over.

List (plan ahead) on the reasons why resisting is good.

Identify (be ready) & know what the negative triggers are.

Keep busy with healthy activities.

Strengthen & focus on your romantic (or other good) relationships.

MAINTAIN CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP

Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their toil. 10 For if they fall, one will lift up his fellow. But woe to him who is alone when he falls and has not another to lift him up! 11 Again, if two lie together, they keep warm, but how can one keep warm alone? 12 And though a man might prevail against one who is alone, two will withstand him—a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

MAINTAIN A CONSISTENT PRAYER LIFE

Philippians 4:6-7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

MAINTAIN A REGULAR BIBLE STUDY HABIT

2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is God-breathed, and is effective for DOCTRINE, for REPROOF, for CORRECTION, for INSTRUCTION in righteousness, that the man of God may be mature & thoroughly equipped for every good work.

DOCTRINE = To Teach (Teach it) CORRECTION = To Set Straight (Fix it)

REPROOF = To Convict (Stop it) INSTRUCTION = To Experience (Live it)
