THE WORD OF GOD

The "Word of God" is "The Word that Comes from God". FOR US, THAT IS THE BIBLE.

THE WORD OF GOD IS REVEALED TO US. (This is called "Revelation")

This is the giving of the truth from God to man. If God had not given it, man would never know it.

1 Corinthians 2:9-10 But as it is written: "Eye has not seen nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him". But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.

Psalm 19:1	The heavens declare (reveal) the glory of God; and the universe shows His creative power.
Acts 14:15	Why are you worshipping dead idols? Turn to the living God Who made the heaven, the earth, the sea, and all the things that are in them.
Romans 1:20	For since the creation of the world God's invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the created things we can see, even His eternal power & Godhead, so that they are without excuse.

THE WORD OF GOD IS WRITTEN DOWN FOR US. (This is called "Inscripturation")

This is the process of putting the revealed thoughts of God into the vocabularies of the human authors.

1 Corinthians 2:12	Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit Who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.
1 Corinthians 2:13 2 Peter 1:20-21	These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches about spiritual things. No preaching (prophecy) of Scripture is of any private interpretation, for proclaiming this message never came by the will of man, BUT holy men of God spoke as they were moved along by the Holy Spirit.

- The Bible text (the Word of God) originated with God (& God alone).
- The Bible text was transferred to the Bible writers by the Holy Spirit's guidance.
- The Bible text was not put in these men like they were robots who would just repeat it.
- God supernaturally transferred the material into their personalities & writing style.

<u>THE WORD OF GOD WAS WRITTEN BY GOD FOR US.</u> (This is called "Inspiration") This is the truth that God's Word is the same as if God were literally speaking it to us.

2 Timothy 3:16 All Scripture is given by inspiration of God and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.

- The entire Bible is inspired, not just the words. (Plenary inspiration)
- The Bible writer knew it was God's Word and needed to write it d own or preach it.
- The Bible writer may not have always understood the full meaning of the message or text.

THE WORD OF GOD WAS WRITTEN FOR US TO OBEY. (This is called "Authority")

This is the expectation by God that His Word be listened to & obeyed.

James 1:22	But be ye doers of the Word and not hearers only; otherwise, you are deceiving yourself.
Romans 13:1	For there is no authority except from God, and any authority that exists is appointed by God.
Acts 17:11	The Bereans were fair-minded - they received the Word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures
	daily to find out whether these things taught were true.
