The words "I am" = an eternal existence of present tense. He has always existed. Everything that matters in life comes from Him; all power comes from Him; He is God Almighty.

## I AM THE WAY, THE TRUTH, AND THE LIFE

John 14:6 Jesus said to Thomas, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me".

- The Jewish leaders were plotting to kill Jesus (John 11:53)
- The Jewish leaders were plotting to kill Lazarus (John 12:10)
- Peter & Thomas both questioned where Jesus was going (after death) (Jn. 13;36; 14:5)
- Jesus predicted that Peter would deny Jesus at the trial (John 13:38)
- The disciples & the Christians in general were deeply troubled (Jn. 14:1).

The word "way" means "to progress on a road." (Christ is the Way).

The word "truth" means "something not concealed". (Christ is the Truth).

The word "life" means "to be alive, physically, and then spiritually." (Christ is the Life).
