STUDY QUESTIONS

1.	What 'group" is being referred to in 2 Kings 2:23?
2.	Elisha the prophet had just healed some bad water in Jericho. (2 Kings 2:20-22) What did they yell at him? (2 Kings 2:23)
3.	Why in the world would young men make a trip out of the city into the country to call the prophet "Old Baldy". Before you answer, keep in mind that Elijah had just gone to heaven supernaturally; also, keep in mind that there were more than 42 young men hassling him.
4.	Isn't it safe to assume that this group had a few leaders who had an issue with Elisha or with God; these few leaders excited a group of over 40 other young guys? Have you ever been in a situation like this. Explain.
5.	If the followers in this group do not want to participate in this verbal attack on Elisha, what could they possibly have done, if anything?
6.	Let's look at the word " <u>multitude</u> ". Some think that this referred to a riotous bunch of people out of control. If they were out of control, the Roman army would have stepped in. Where was the multitude coming from? (Matt. 26:47)
7.	This multitude took ahold of Jesus physically and took him where? (Mt 26:27)
8.	Who persuaded the multitude to ask that Jesus be executed? (Mt. 27:20)
9.	What about the "evil doers" described in Micah 2:1-2? This group has plenty of bad activities planned. Who did the planning? The whole group all at once? No! A few leaders did & then told the rest of the group to do it. Does this sound familiar? "Devising evil plans, doing it in the dark, showing everyone you have power over them, taking property & belongings by violence, threatening people."
