2 Chronicles 33:20 - So Manasseh died. His son, Amon, became king. 2 Chronicles 33:21 - Amon was 22 when he became king; he reigned two years. He did evil in the sight of the Lord. 2 Chronicles 33:24-25 - King Amon's palace servants murdered him. The nation made Amon's son, Josiah, to be king. 2 Chronicles 34:1 - Josiah was 8 years old when he became king. He did what was right in the eyes of the Lord.

2 Kings 22:1 - Josiah was 8 years old when he became king, and he reigned 31 years in Jerusalem. His mother's name was <u>Jedidah</u> . 2 Kings 22:8-10 - Then <u>Hilkiah</u> the high priest said to <u>Staphan</u> the scribe, "I have found the Book of the Law in the house of the Lord." Then Shaphan the scribe showed King Josiah the "Book". 2 Chronicles 35:25 - <u>Jeremiah</u> lamented for Josiah who was killed in battle. (Age 39) Jeremiah 1:2 - The Word of the Lord came to Jeremiah in the days of King Josiah. Zephaniah 1:1 - The Word of the Lord came to <u>Zephaniah</u> in the days of Josiah, king of Judah.
