

MAKING A CHANGE - Moses

Life is full of change. Sometimes, the changes we make are not good. However, don't forget the positive changes you have made. Let's check out a Biblical case study.

Exodus 3:1-6 - Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law. He led the flock to the back side of the desert and came near Mt. Horeb, the mountain of God. The Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a burning bush which was not being consumed. It caught his attention so he stopped to check it out. When God saw that Moses turned aside to look, God called, "Moses, Moses". Moses answered, "Here I am." God said, "This is holy ground; take off your shoes; don't come any closer. I am God of your ancestors, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob." Moses hid his face; he was afraid to look at God.
