Is there really anything listed above regarding Peter that is not true of us also? Does any of this stuff disqualify him from being a believer? Does any of this stuff drive away God's love from him? Peter was a normal guy with all the "ups-and-downs" we have. Notice Matt. 26:75. After Peter screwed up, "he WENT OUT and cried". God did not say, "you are no good". Peter said to himself, "I am no good."

Notice Luke 24:49 - "But all His acquaintances and the women who had followed Him from Galilee, STOOD AT A DISTANCE, watching." Peter was one of these. He had failed; he denied that he even knew Jesus. He checked out on his life as a believer. His life of usefulness was over. He gave up the **one chance** he had to make a difference in his family, his community, and in the group of believers he had come to love. He gave up on himself but Jesus had not. That "**Jesus of second chances**" met him on the beach.
