## The Door

## John 10:7,9

Then Jesus spoke to them again, "This is the absolute truth; I am the door of the sheep. Yes, I am the door; If you enter through Me, you will be saved, and will go out and find pasture."

**9** Now as *Jesus* passed by, He saw a man who was blind from birth.<sup>2</sup> And His disciples asked "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?" <sup>3</sup> Jesus answered, "Neither this man nor his parents sinned, but that the works of God should be revealed in him. <sup>6</sup>When He had said these things, He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva; and He anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay. <sup>7</sup>And He said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam". So he went and washed, and came back seeing. <sup>8</sup>Therefore the neighbors and those who previously had seen that he was blind said, "Is not this he who sat and begged?" <sup>9</sup>Some said, "This is he." Others said, <sup>[]</sup>"He is like him." He said, "I am he." <sup>10</sup> Therefore they said to him, "How were vour eves opened?" <sup>11</sup>He answered and said, "A Man called Jesus made clay and anointed my eyes and said to me, 'Go to <sup>[d]</sup>the pool of Siloam and wash.' So I went and washed, and I received sight." <sup>13</sup> They brought him who formerly was blind to the Pharisees. <sup>14</sup> Now it was a Sabbath when Jesus made the clay and opened his eyes. <sup>15</sup> Then the Pharisees also asked him again how he had received his sight. He said to them, "He put clay on my eyes, and I washed, and I see." <sup>16</sup> Therefore some of the Pharisees said. "This Man is not from God, because He does not ekep the Sabbath." <sup>27</sup> He answered them, "I told you already, and you did not listen. Why do you want to hear it again? <sup>30</sup> He has opened my eyes! <sup>34</sup> They answered and said to him, "You were completely born in sins, and are you teaching us?" And they fast him out. <sup>35</sup> Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when He had found him, He said to him, "Do you believe in the Son of <sup>[g]</sup>God?" <sup>36</sup>He answered and said, "Who is He, Lord, that I may believe in Him?" <sup>37</sup> And Jesus said to him, "You have both seen Him and it is He who is talking with you." <sup>38</sup> Then he said, "Lord, I believe!" And He worshiped Him. 10 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door, but climbs up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber.<sup>2</sup> But he who enters by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. and he calls before them; and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice.
