



LESSON 2 - Abraham

If you were with us for the first lesson featuring "Isaiah", I think that we came to an amazing conclusion: God was not looking for results/victory <u>ALL AROUND</u> Isaiah, BUT RATHER victory/results <u>INSIDE</u> Isaiah.

Noah had three sons: Shem, Ham, Japheth. They became the fathers of the world's nations.

- 1. Look up Genesis 11:27. Who was Abram's father? ___
- 2. Genesis 11:28 What was Abram's home country called?

Abram was born approximately 2860 years after Shem.

3. __Yes __No Did Abram & his brothers have any choice where they lived? Japheth & his descendants settled in the territory we call Europe today.

Ham & his descendants settled in the territory we call Africa today.

Shem & his descendants settled in the territory we all the Middle East. ALL THE BIBLE CHARACTERS THAT LEAD TO JESUS CHRIST COME FROM THE DESCENDANTS OF SHEM.

Genesis 12:1 - Now the Lord said to Abram, "Get out of your country, from your family, from your father's house to a land that to a land that I will show you."

Genesis 11:31-32 Terah took his family out of Ur of the Chaldeans, heading for Israel (Canaan). They stopped & lived there.

Father Terah and brother Haran died in that town of Haran.

Genesis 12:4 Abram left Haran with his nephew, Lot, and headed for Canaan.

4. What three things did God command Abram to give up?

God wasn't messing around here; this was God Almighty talking to a simple descendant of Shem (Abram). It appears that one of Abram's ancestors (Arphaxad's family) founded Ur of the Chaldeans. They worshipped all kinds of gods there. Regardless of what Abram's family line worshipped, God called him out of there.

10. Look in Genesis 12:8. What town did Abram settle in before his mistake?
11. Look in Genesis 13:3-4. What town did Abram return to after his mistake?
12. Look in Genesis 13:14-17YesNo Did God give up on Abram after the mistake?
Genesis 13:18 says that Abram moved his tent and went where God said.
13YesNo Could this mean, "Lord, here I am <u>again;</u> send me?"
Genesis 14:1-17 describes all kinds of political & military turmoil with the little kingdoms around the area. Abram's nephew, Lot, got caught in the middle of the mess.
14. Why should Abram go to the rescue? Oh, I know -sure - sure - Lot is family - BUT
a. He came from an evil, idolatrous family in Ur of the Chaldeans.
b. His father, Haran, died early & possibly did not train the family properly.
c. Lot let his family clan staff fight with Abram's family clan staff.
d. Lot was selfish & picked what he thought was the best land to settle in.
e. Lot chose to live near evil towns and evil people.
