- 2. Before the pregnancy & birth, what did their father (Isaac) pray? (Gen. 25:21)
- 3. \_\_\_Yes \_\_\_No Did Esau and Jacob look alike at birth? (Gen. 25:27)
- 4. What did they look like? Esau: \_\_\_\_\_\_ Jacob:

Based on the description of the boys, and based on scientific study, we know that these boys were not IDENTICAL, but rather FRATERNAL.

FRATERNAL = Two separate eggs fertilized by two separate sperm, thus, two separate people. They just happened to have both been born at the same birth event.

- In Genesis 25:27, the text says "so the boys grew". This means "have grown up". What did each boy grow up to be?

## <u>A Little Summary</u>

- We cannot read Esau's heart, but he appeared to not be focused on God's plan.
- Therefore, even though he was the first born, God could not use him to lead the family
- Obviously, God could have accomplished His plan without Jacob & Rebekah cheating.
- So far, Esau has been hurt & offended by his brother and his mother.

Genesis 27:35Isaac said to Esau, "Your brother came with deceit and has taken away your blessing."Genesis 27:38Esau said, "Father, do you only have one blessing? Is there a blessing for me." Esau lifted up his voice & wept.Genesis 27:41So Esau hated Jacob. He thought to himself, "As soon as my father dies, I will kill my brother, Jacob."

It is possible that Jacob was terrified of Esau during their meeting (repeatedly saying, "If I have found your favor," Unless I am missing something with the culture here, possibly no <u>confessing fault</u> or <u>forgiving the other</u> happened that day.
