- Exodus 20:3** *"You shall have no other gods instead of Me."*
- Exodus 20:4** *"You shall make no images (idols) to replace or supplement Me."*
- Exodus 20:7** *"You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain."*
- Exodus 20:8** *"Remember the Sabbath day and keep it holy."*

The first four Commandments talk about how we treat God. Remember, we are created in the "image of God". Are we treating God like family?
