2YN	God created man (general human term). This general human term "man" had
Genesis 1:1 Psalm 90:1-2 John 1:3	two genders – male & female. God created both of them. He had no confusion. In the beginning of God's creating activities, God created the heavens and the earth. Lord, You have been our caregiver for our entire existence. Before you made us, before You made the mountains, before you formed the earth and the world, from the eternal past to the eternal future, You are God Supreme, and You have always been God Supreme. Jesus (the Word) was with God the Father before any beginning that we could think of (infinity).
John 8:58 Exodus 3:14	Jesus responded to the Jewish leaders, "This is the absolute truth, before Abraham existed, I had already existed forever." ("I AM") And God responded to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM."

Genesis 3:6 Genesis 2:8-9	So the woman saw that the tree was <u>good</u> for food, that it was <u>pleasant</u> to the eyes, and a tree <u>desirable</u> to make one wise; she took of the tree's fruit and ate it. The Lord God planted a garden in Eden, and there he put the man He had created. And out of the ground the Lord God made every tree grow that is pleasant to the sight and good for food. "The Tree of Life" and the "Tree of the Knowledge of Good and evil (TKGE)" were both in the garden with all the other trees.
Genesis 1:31	Then God saw <u>everything</u> that He had made, and <u>indeed</u> it was very good.
