The Bottom Line

- God wanted a relationship with man always & He showed that by the creation of man. (Gen. 1)
- God is holy and wanted man to enjoy an eternal lifetime surrounded by holiness & satisfaction.
- Man listened to the devil, deemed God a liar, and chose to disobey God's commands.
- Man became a sinner at that moment; man became separated from God at that moment.
- Holiness and sin cannot fellowship together; man was removed from the garden where God was.

Romans 5:12-13 Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way, death came to all men, because all sinned- ¹³ for before the law was given, sin was in the world. But sin is not taken into account when there is no law. ¹⁴ Nevertheless, death reigned from the time of Adam to the time of Moses, even over those who did not sin by breaking a command, as did Adam, who was a pattern of the one to come.
