Lesson 2F - How does God Communicate with us?

Keep in mind that before people had (or wanted) access to the Bible, God used other ways.



THROUGH PARTS OF THE HOLY SCRIPTURES

- In the early days of the Bible, the communication between God and man was verbal (like between Adam & God).
- However, fathers usually recorded things somehow so as to pass the history on to their descendants.
- Cain & Abel knew about sacrifices & God. Adam told them that.
- The Chaldeans wrote things down. Abraham grew up there.
- The Egyptians wrote things down. Moses grew up there.
- Moses wrote the Law; the Jews carried that Law while traveling.

• 3. 4. 5.	At that time, Israel's Bible was called the Law of God and contained the information that is recorded in Exodus 20 - Leviticus 27. All during their travels, they carried the Law in the Ark of the Covenant all the way to Canaan. Who was teaching this Law to the people? (Deut. 1:5) Who is supposed to read this Law first? (Deut. 17:18) Who wrote down this Law for priests? (Deut. 31:9) How were the people to hear the Law? (Deut. 31:11)
	What good will the Law be for the people? (Joshua 1:8-9) (Remember, this is their Bible.)
<u>More</u>	Details Moses wrote down all the material in Genesis - Deuteronomy before he died (5 Books of the Law) For the rest of the Old Testament years, these books were copied by priests & scribes. The years in the book of Judges were evil; there is NO mention of the Law in Judges. However, in the Judges time, a man named Boaz knew parts of the Law & obeyed it. (Ruth 4:4) There is no mention of the Law of God in the books of 1 & 2 Samuel; that isn't good.

<u>Some</u>	Final Thoughts
•	In Ezra 7:10, the Law that Ezra read to the people was probably Genesis - Deuteronomy.

- In 2 Kings 22:8, scholars think the lost part of the Law found was only Deuteronomy.
- By the end of the Old Testament, probably all the Old Testament books were written & available.
 - a. In Luke 4:4, Jesus quoted from Deuteronomy; In Luke 4:18, Jesus quoted from Isaiah.
 - b. In Luke 24:44, Jesus mentioned the entire Old Testament (The Law, the Poetry Writings, the Prophets)
 - c. This Old Testament would have been the Bible for the New Testament believers also. Paul's letters were written before 64 AD. Some N.T. believers read them; The rest of the New Testament was written between 75AD & 100AD.
