Let's Get Started

- The only creation that can reflect God's image & character is MAN.
- All the rest of God's creation (heavens and earth) were created for MAN.
- God's plan was to give MAN a purpose for life, and then enjoy helping him do it forever.
- MAN knew all this, yet he chose to question & disobey God; that's what we call "sin".
- That "sin" polluted MAN'S nature, and disqualified him from being in God's holy presence.
- God STILL has a plan for MAN, and He STILL wants to help him with that purpose forever.

•	• "in Christ Jesus" means "to be a believer in Jesus as your Savior.			
•	 "once far off" means "before you were a believer, you were separated from God."

5.	5. What is more likely? In order for the separation between God & man to be removed:			
	God needs	to do something first Man needs to do something first.		
•	 The term used to describe <u>God and man being separated</u> is "Spiritual Death". 			
•	 When anything is dead, no human being can fix that; man cannot make a dead thing alive. 			
•	• God, however, has the power to make a dead thing come alive if He chooses to.			

- That dead thing could be the physical body, or it could be the spiritual part of a person.
- Keep in mind that the physical body will stop existing one day; the spiritual part exists forever.

Ephesians 2:1-3 - As for you, you were <u>dead</u> in your transgressions and sins, 2 in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient. 3 All of us also lived among them at one time, gratifying the cravings of our flesh $^{[a]}$ and following its desires and thoughts. Like the rest, we were by nature deserving of wrath. 4 But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, 5 <u>made us alive</u> with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions - it is by grace you have been saved.

Life Goes On					
• Sex and children continued. (Genesis 4:1)					
The sons learned trades: Cain worked the soil, and Abel tended animals. (Gen. 4:2)					
• Sometime during this period, the boys learned to make sacrifices to God for worship. (Gen. 4:4)					
Genesis 4:6-7 - So the Lord said to Cain, "Why are you angry? [It shows in your face.] If you do well (My way), will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well (Your way), sin lies at the door. And its desire is for you, but you should rule over it."

Separation from God still Exists					
 In this condition, man cannot get away from guilt, over-using human effort, wandering in life, fearing punishment, expecting pending danger, & seeing sin repeat itself. (Gen. 4:11-16) 					
6. But God is still at work during the godless period between Adam & the Flood: Adam's son,, was born; later his grandson,, was born. Both these men followed God in an evil generation. (Gen. 4:25-26). God's rescue was still underway.
