

The four units in this course are: Temperament & Personality, Spiritual Gifts, Personal Testimony Development, and Doctrinal Statement

Development. There are 10 men in this class. They have concentrated on who they are early in the class. Now, they are studying what they believe. Pray for these guys. They have a major impact on the men they live with, and with the church service programming in their respective prison yards.



Pray with us as we turn a new corner in our lives & ministry. The income we received through Mom Huff & Aunt Orpha has & is coming to an end. Mom Huff went to Heaven & Aunt Orpha is moving to New Mexico. Liz is beginning part-time
