

**A PRAYER I NEED** 

Lord, I Thank You.

Matthew 11:25

You must pray in your own life so that God can build the character you need to reach into someone else's life.

## <u>A Few Thoughts</u>

- When we pray, we talk to the Lord; we don't see Him.
- When the <u>disciples</u> prayed, they talked to the Lord; they saw Him.
- Prayer is communicating with Jesus connecting our hearts with His.
- 1. Who said, "I thank You, Lord of heaven & earth". \_\_\_\_\_
- 2. Look at Matthew 11:25. What word did I leave out? \_\_\_\_\_ (Hold that thought.)
- There are three verses in Matthew where someone is thanking God. (11:25; 15:36; 26:27). In all three cases, the person is Jesus. No other person in the whole book is recorded thanking God.
- 3. Can you explain that? \_\_\_\_\_
- Does that mean "no person in those three years" ever thanked God for anything; of course not. It just means that Matthew never wrote any down.
- Mark & John only wrote down Jesus' prayers; Luke recorded two other people praying.

## Luke's Input.

- 4. Who thanked God in Luke 2:38?
- 5. Who thanked God in Luke 17:16?
- 6. Why did these people thank the Lord at this moment in their lives?
  - a. (Luke 2:38) \_\_\_God did something for her. \_\_\_God kept a promise.
  - b. (Luke 17:16)- \_\_\_God did something for him. \_\_\_God kept a promise.
- 7. Look at the prayer by Paul in Acts 28:15. \_\_Is it practiced? \_\_Is it automatic?

## <u>Matthew's Input</u>

- 8. In the entire gospel, who is the main character being written about? \_\_\_\_\_
- 9. When Jesus prayed, what was He teaching the disciples?
- 10. Since Jesus & His Father are the same God, why would Jesus thank His Father; that would be like thanking yourself?

## Bottom Line

- 11. \_\_\_Yes \_\_\_N If you loved Jesus, couldn't you "thank Him" for no immediate reason?
- 12. What kind of habit should you and I develop in our lives?\_\_\_\_\_
- 13. What good comes out of thanking God? (Acts 28:15)
