A Few Thoughts

- When we pray, we talk to the Lord; we don't see Him.
- When the <u>disciples</u> prayed, they talked to the Lord; they saw Him.
- Prayer is communicating with Jesus connecting our hearts with His.
- 1. The disciples asked Jesus why He often used parables in Matt. 13:10. Were they more concerned about the _____crowds understanding or _____themselves understanding?
- Ok, let me be honest. If I was a disciple with Jesus, I would want the people to think I understood everything being said; I know prideful & dishonest.
- 2. Read Matt. 13:10-35. Keep in mind that this gathering included Jesus, His disciples, and a great crowd of people.
 - a. ___Yes ___No Did the disciples ask Jesus to explain the parable in Matt. 13:10?
 - b. ___Yes ___No Did Jesus think the disciples wanted to understand (Matt. 13:16)?

LOOK AT THIS.

- Jesus explained the parable to them even though they did not ask. (13:18-23)
- Jesus then told them three parables in a row without explanation (13:24-33).
- 3. __Yes __No Do you think Jesus wanted them to ask the meanings?
- 4. The disciples finally ask Jesus to explain a parable in 13:36.
 - a. Where was the crowd?
 - b. Where were Jesus & the disciples? _____
- Jesus proceeded to tell three more parables to them in private. (13:44-50)
- 5. What did Jesus ask them after He was done? (13:51) _____
- 6. How did the disciples answer Him? (13:51) _____
- 7. __Yes __No Do you think they understood everything He just taught them?
- We cannot possibly understand lots of things in the Bible; the disciples didn't.
