		What had God already told Moses in Numbers 20:12?
	•	There are consequences for our sins; God wants us to understand that. One way to
		prove you understand is to tell God in prayer that "I messed up; I sinned".

		Was perfect (4); would provide for him (13); would save him (15); created him (18); would
		punish justly (30); was the only G od (31); would protect him (37).
