A Few Thoughts

- When we pray, we talk to the Lord; we don't see Him.
- When the <u>disciples</u> prayed, they talked to the Lord; they saw Him.
- Prayer is communicating with Jesus connecting our hearts with His.
- 1. Where were the disciples when they yelled out this prayer (Matt. 8:23-25)?
- It is possible that not all 12 of the disciples were called yet, so we're not sure who was in the ship. Chances are they were all fisherman.
- 2. __Yes __No Do you think this was the first storm on the sea they'd been in?
- 3. Storms are very intense on the sea, but why did they freak out like this?

Before the Boat Ride

- These disciples were new at this; they had been called by Jesus recently.
- They saw something new & incredible the healing of many people. (They saw it.)
- They heard an overwhelming sermon that scared them to death.
- 4. __Yes __No Don't you think they were already perishing (drowning) in their heads & wondering what they had gotten themselves into before the storm?

Don't Be Hard on these Men.

- Sure, they saw Jesus was sleeping while the ship was about to sink. He wasn't doing anything to help them.
- BUT, You and I feel the same. Our personal ship (life) is sinking and we cannot see Him; we don't know if He is helping or not. (maybe, even asleep?)
- 5. ___Yes ___No Did Jesus wake up and tell the men not to bother Him?
- 6. Could Jesus be hurt by what we do. "I am here with you; why are you afraid?" Explain.
- 7. Don't be afraid to call out, "Lord, help me quick; I am drowning here." What good will it do for you and me? (Matt. 8:27) ______
- 8. __Yes __No Did Jesus answer that prayer right there in the sea?
- 9. ___Yes ___No Did that answer equip them later in life to prove God's presence?
